Saturday and holiday break athletic events that are considered to be non-league and voluntary, will not receive district provided transportation. If the team wants to use a district bus, they will need to pay the district field trip rate. These funds can be allocated from Booster Club accounts.

League and state tournaments will not fall into the category of a voluntary event. Invitational tournaments and tournaments for baseball, competitive cheer, cross country, golf, soccer, softball, swimming, tennis, volleyball and wrestling will be considered “voluntary” even though the events are scheduled as part of the MHSAA allowable maximum for that particular sport. There are some events where transportation will be provided at the discretion of the Athletic Director and the Administration of the school involved.

It will be the responsibility of the coach and the parents of the participants to get team members to the site of the contest for Saturday and holiday break events.

In district transportation for contests between Wayne Memorial and John Glenn will be provided for after school events during the week on a drop off basis only. Parents will be responsible for getting their child home from the event. Examples of these events include freshmen basketball games, tennis matches, cross country meets, baseball and softball games. Events not included under this umbrella are events that begin in the evening such as JV and varsity basketball games, volleyball matches, wrestling matches, competitive cheer and swim meets.
